Seats for students are limited and a selection will be performed in case of high number of applications. For this reason, we kindly ask to applicant students to attach to the application the Curriculum Vitae, in either English or Italian, with the most recent academic transcript (details about courses successfully attended and marks obtained). **This item is not required for professors and researchers.**

The confirmation of acceptance will be sent by email to the applicants. Also the link and the password to join the event will be provided approximately one week before the event.
